QUESTIONS & ANSWERS:

Is the Motorcycle Temporary Permit included in taking the Harley-Davidson New Rider Course?

Will the Harley-Davidson New Rider Course get me my motorcycle endorsement?

The Harley-Davidson New Rider Course will allow passing riders to get their endorsement within 60-days of successfully completing their class without any additional testing.

Is this class mandatory?

Only for minors between 15 1/2 and 17 years old.

If I have a motorcycle endorsement on my current driver's license, take the class and fail that class, will that failure affect my license or endorsement?

No.

My driver's license is expired or suspended. Can I take the class?

My motorcycle temporary permit is expired. Can I take the class?

No. You need to renew your permit prior to the class.

I want to register for the class. Where can I find the dates and times? How do I register?

You may find the schedule and register on-line or contact the program manager.

Do you offer any Trike/3-wheeled classes?

No. However, obtaining your Motorcycle Endorsement will allow you to ride on two-wheeled and three-wheeled vehicles.

What does Harley-Davidson provide in the class? What do I need to provide?

<u>Dealership provides</u>: certified coaches, safe & positive learning environment, knowledgeable staff, coffee & water, lunch on the weekend, roadbook, workbook, Street 500 or LWZ350RA motorcycle to use during the 25-hour class.

<u>Student provides</u>: driver's license, motorcycle temporary permit, positive attitude, DOT approved helmet, protective eyewear, full-fingered gloves, long sleeves & pants (during riding sessions), overthe-ankle footwear, rain gear (if needed), commitment to attend 100% of class.

What is the price of the Harley-Davidson New Rider Course?

Are there any pre-qualifications for the class?

Balance. We also suggest you stop in and sit on the bikes or utilize the "Jump Start" if the dealership is equipped with one. This will allow you the opportunity to start up a motorcycle and run through the gears (just one if that's all you want – or more) while the motorcycle is stationary. Don't worry! Even if you don't know what you are doing....the motorcycle won't go anywhere. That's the point. Practice and have fun. This equipment is available for you! Once you're riding and out on the street, you won't need it anymore.
